#### **Required Tools & Materials**

- □ Fur felt capeline of your choice
- Open crown block
- □ Flange (brim block) with string groove
- Conformateur / Flex Curve (flexible ruler)
- □ Stand (block stand or dowel on a base)
- □ Steam iron and ironing board
- Handheld steamer, hat steamer or other source of steam
- □ Foot tolliker (thumb dummy)
- □ Cord / Blocking string
- □ Ferrule (wire connector)
- □ Hat jack / Band stretcher block
- Puller downer
- Sewing machine (with fabric and leather needles)
- □ Blocking spring
- □ Brim legs / Brim stand (for flange)
- □ Silk or cotton lining fabric
- □ Heavy duty interfacing
- □ Heavy muslin cotton sheet
- □ 9½" length hat ribbon of your choice
- □ Leather sweatband
- □ Sweatband bow
- □ Neoprene coated or rubber gloves
- Pen, paper and pencil
- Scalpel (X-Acto knife)
- □ Scissors
- Pinking shears
- □ Pliers or self-locking pliers
- Polycotton press cloth
- □ A weight
- □ Needle and thread
- □ Thimble

- Mini bulldog clip
- Quilter's clips
- □ Glass head pins
- □ Steel edge ruler
- □ Tailor's chalk
- □ Tape measure
- □ Sanding block\*
- Sandpaper (800 & 1200 grit, plus 300 grit if you are working with heavy felt)
- □ 3M non-abrasive pad
- □ Vinyl painter's tape
- □ Water in spray bottle
- □ Vacuum with brush attachment
- □ Refuse sack (bin bag)
- □ Washing up bowl

\*Get a small offcut of wood and cover base with required sandpaper. Hardware stores also sell sanding blocks.

- □ Rounding jack
- □ Step stool
- Dust mask
- □ Fractionated coconut oil
- Shellac thinner or denatured alcohol in spray bottle
- □ Plywood board with a central hole /
- Brim plate
- Small French iron
- Pastry roller / Rolling pin
- Wooden spatula
- Baseball

## Size Advice

# When buying your blocks (crown, brim/flange and band stretcher block) matching oval profiles and sizes that work together is crucial.

Guy Morse-Brown Hat Blocks give the following size example:.

If you want a hat to fit a 58cm head size then you will need equipment in the following sizes:

- Crown 59cm
- Brim 61cm
- Band Stretcher Block 58cm

These tolerances allow for felt thickness and sewing in a leather sweatband.

The ovals also need to relate to each other - eg. all components are regular oval form (OVAL 36).
